In the initial stage of the Review the Council will publish details of its existing polling districts and places together with proposals for any changes that are deemed necessary. This will include maps showing the area served by each polling station and details of the electorate, the facilities available and the accessibility of each building. It is also strongly recommended that details of any significant population changes or shifts that are likely to occur before the next review (in 2023) should be included.
